



New Trees and Shrubs

On Tuesday, April 30th we are scheduled to receive 24 assorted trees and 40+ shrubs being delivered by Great Plains Nursery to be added to the landscape. All the trees will be planted, staked, and mulched by Great Plains in the west field of the Pollinating Garden and on the 102nd Street right of way replacing the Ash trees removed last year. We have been fortunate to have received recent donations earmarked specifically for
